In September 2017, the hospital expanded its outpatient capabilities with a state-of-the-art infusion center. Under the leadership of Bhoomi Mehrotra, MD, director of the Cancer Institute at St. Francis and system-wide oncology service line chair, the CHS Cancer Center at St. Joseph Hospital, a six-chair infusion unit, will provide intravenous therapy in a safe, convenient and controlled environment. While complex cancer surgery and radiation oncology may best be concentrated in a tertiary care setting, biological and chemotherapy treatments can be administered safely in a community hospital-based infusion center, offering patients greater access and reducing the stress associated with traveling.
